
Session Objectives

Strategies



Digital Reading Portfolio

Use of capturing samples of students reading to encourage improvement



Graphic Organizers

Helps students organize thoughts and processes to clearly help with comprehension



iPods/iRead

Checking out iPods with print copies of books so that they can listen and read builds fluency

Strategies



Gaming Software

Cranium Core builds comprehension and excitement for reading



Podcast

Students talk about reading through discussion and book talks



Web Chats

Interact with authors or software designers to learn more about the process

- Capture students reading samples throughout the year






